Ariz. law bans abortions based on race or gender

PHOENIX -- Arizona Gov. Jan Brewer has signed what is likely the first legislation in the nation to ban abortions over ethnicity.

The law makes it a felony to perform or provide financing for an abortion sought because of the race or sex of the fetus or a parent's race.

Supporters say the measure is an important statement against discrimination and for life.

Critics say there's no evidence that selective abortions occur in Arizona, and doctors could face jail time if they lose an affidavit that an abortion isn't for selection purposes. EMAIL
